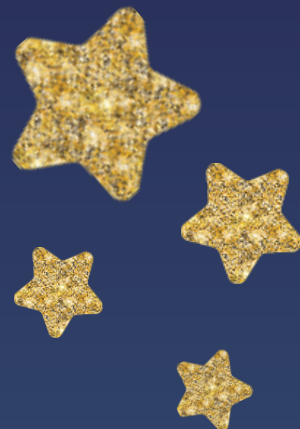

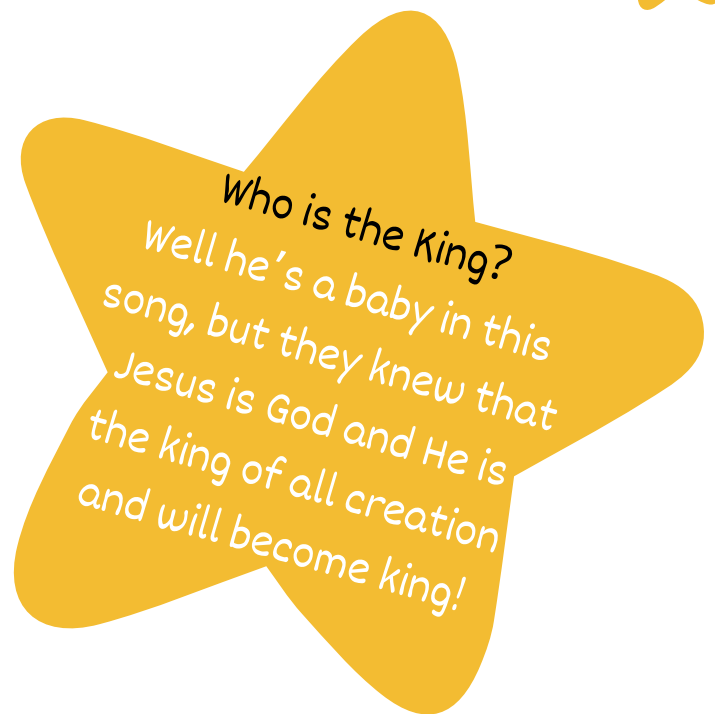

Christ the Lord!



Sing, choirs of angels,
